Presentation

This course focuses on the specialized evaluation of pelvic floor disorders using urodynamic testing and ultrasound.

There is a need for the education of the Gynaecology specialists in Urogynaecology and Pelvic Floor Dysfunction. From the Education Committee EUGA (European Urogynaecological Association), we have assessed the necessity to educate in the advanced diagnostic techniques for patients with pelvic floor disorders, especially urodynamics and ultrasound for women with urinary incontinence, pelvic

organ prolapse and other urogynaecological dysfunctions. The main education aim of this course is to increase the knowledge of the gynaecologists, with a special interest in Urogynaecology, in the advanced diagnostic techniques.

The course will offer an overview from the basic knowledge of these techniques to advanced ones and how they can help for managing complex patient groups, such as elderly patients, neurological patients and those with voiding dysfunction.
